

REGULATION
on Conduction of II International Children and Youth Guitar Playing Contest
of Russian Music

1. General Provisions

1.1. II International Children and Youth Guitar Playing Contest of Russian Music (hereinafter – the Contest) shall be conducted in Kaliningrad among students of educational institutions of culture and art, culture and leisure institutions, students of Kaliningrad Regional Musical College, other regions of Russia and foreign countries.

1.2. The Contest shall be conducted on March 25-26, 2021.

2. Contest Founders and Organizers

2.1. The Ministry of Culture of Kaliningrad region;

2.2. Regional State Budget Educational Institution of Further Vocational Education “Educational and Methodical Center”;

2.3. Municipal Autonomous Educational Institution of Children Supplementary Education of City District “Kaliningrad City” “M.I. Glinka Children`s Music School”;

3. Contest Objects and Tasks

3.1. To preserve and strengthen the best traditions of the Russian music culture in the most western region of Russia.

3.2. To create conditions for detecting new talented performers among guitar students.

3.3. To establish a creative environment for spiritual, moral and professional education of musicians.

3.4. To bring up children audience and raise awareness to children`s musical creative work.

3.5. To improve professional skills and exchange academic experience.

3.6. To improve young musicians` performance skills.

4. Contest Terms and Procedure

4.1. The Contest shall consist of one round.

4.2. The Contest shall have 2 nominations:

- Solo-performers
- Groups (duos, trios, quarters etc., guitar and other instrument.

4.3. The Contest shall be conducted in five age groups:

- I group through 9 years old;
- II group through 10-11 years old;
- III group through 12-13 years old;
- IV group through 14-17 years old;
- V group: Music College students

4.4. The age of participants shall be determined on the first Contest day – March 24, 2021.

4.5. Groups shall be classified into the age groups by the oldest participant age.

4.6. One teacher may perform in groups of 4 and more performers, two teachers may perform in groups of 6 and more performers.

4.7. The program shall be performed by heart in the “Solo-performers” nomination. The piece playing sequence shall be determined by a contestant.

4.8. The contest program shall be allowed to be played from score in the “Groups” nomination.

4.9. Any changes in the stated program shall be reported to the organizing committee at least for two weeks before commencement of the Contest.

4.10. Contest auditions shall be open for public in the M.I. Glinka Children`s Music School Concert Hall.

4.11. The performance sequence of participants in the Contest shall be determined at the draw.

5. Program Requirements

5.1. Program requirements for solo performers:

- A piece by a Russian composer;
- Obligatory piece;
- Optional piece.

5.2. The list of obligatory pieces for solo-performers:

Group I

A. Ivanov-Kramskoy. Sad tune

Group II

A. Vinitsky. Biloved little worm from wild strawberries

Group III

V. Kozlov. Burlesque

Group IV

N. Koshkin. Ballad №1

Group V (Music College students)

S.Rudnev. Like ours at the gate

5.3. Program requirements for groups:

- A piece by a Russian composer
- One-two optional pieces

5.4. Program execution time - I group up to 6 minutes; Group II up to 8 minutes; Group III up to 10 minutes; Group IV up to 12 minutes; Group V up to 15 min.

6. Contest Jury

6.1. The Contest Jury shall include leading Russian and foreign specialists.

6.2. The Jury shall be headed by the Chairman. Any organizational and technical work shall be carried out by the secretary.

6.3. The Jury members presenting their students at the Contest, shall not participate in discussion of their performance.

6.4. The Jury shall be entitled not to award all the prizes or award the same prize to several performers.

6.5. The Jury and organizing committee shall reserve a right to establish new and incentive prizes.

6.6. Decision of the Jury shall be final and not subject to reconsideration.

7. Awarding the Contestants

7.1. By decision of the Jury the contestants winning the I-st, II-nd and III-d prizes shall be awarded with a Laureate title of respective rank, diplomas and prizes.

7.2. Participant winning the IV-th prize, shall be awarded with a Diploma winner title, diploma and a souvenir.

7.3. The contestants shall be awarded with participation certificates.

7.4. The Contest Laureates will take part in the final gala-concert.

8. Financing Terms

8.1. Target contribution for participation in the Contest shall amount to:

- For solo-performers – 1500 (one and a half thousand) roubles;
- For groups - 2000 (two thousand five hundred) roubles.

8.2. The payment shall be transferred to the school`s business account. The target contribution payment receipt shall be produced by a participant at registration. In case of failure to attend the Contest, the target contribution amount shall not be repayed.

8.3. Any expenses related to the visit of participants and their accompanying persons to the Contest (round trip ticket, hotel accommodation, daily allowance) shall be paid by referring organizations or contestants.

8.4. The organizing committee may book a hotel for non-resident participants. An application for booking the required rooms (quantity, category) shall be sent to the organizing committee before February 15, 2021.

ATTENTION!

Entrance to the territory of Kaliningrad region is made:

- By plane – a Russian passport is required;
- By train or car – a Russian foreign passport is required;
- A Russian visa or MRG card is required for foreign citizens.

9. Document Submission Procedure

9.1. The documents for participation in the Contest shall be sent in before **February 15, 2021.**

9.2. A completed application shall be submitted in hard copy or electronic format, affixed by signature of the Head and seal of the institution. The following shall be attached to the application:

- application (see attached);
- a copy of birth certificate (please bring the original at the Contest registration);
- a picture (sign your last name on the reverse).

9.3. Incomplete set of documents shall not be registered.
